## HOW TO CHECK IF THE AGENT IS REALLY ON YOUR SIDE

For most Australians, their home is their biggest financial asset and it is so important to take extreme care when appointing someone to handle the sale of it. Financial security that has taken years to accumulate deserves the utmost care and protection.

Not many people give their best friends the keys to their home yet many willingly hand them over to an agent who is a virtual stranger.

Our recommendation is to take your time and choose your agent carefully. A little bit of research can make a huge difference.
